Study:

- What do you know about Jesus’ triumphant entry into Jerusalem?
- **Read: Mark 11:1-11, Matthew 21:1-11, & Luke 19:28-40**
 - Compare the different versions of this story throughout the Synoptic Gospels. Do you see any differences or similarities?
 - Why might these be significant?
 - What is the donkey significant for this “triumphal entry?”
 - The Greek word we know as “Hosanna” literally means “Save Now.” The people were shouting this as Jesus entered into Jerusalem. What might be the significance of this?
- **Read: John 12:12-19**
 - Do you notice any differences or similarities from this text compared to the Synoptic Gospels?
 - What is the significance of the current day Church’s use of palms in worship?
 - What is so triumphant about this arrival?
