This Phone number and meeting ID will work from week-to-week.

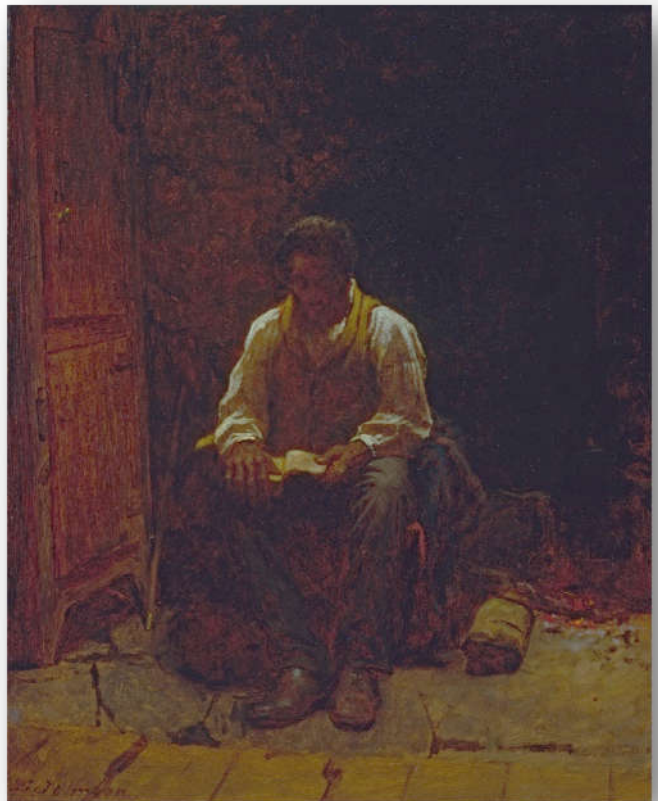
Tip: If you are not speaking, I encourage you to mute your phone to cut down on background noise during the lesson, and when you wish to speak, just unmute your phone.

 - As you read/hear this familiar psalm in different ways, what sticks out to you?
 - Reread the first three verses.
 - What message is the psalmist trying to convey?
 - Amid our current situation of Pandemic, what “green pasture” or “still water” is God leading you to?
 - How do you feel God’s guiding hand in your life?

- Reread Verse 4
 - Imagine what might the Valley of the Shadow of Death may look like to you.
 - What do we learn about God from this verse?
- Reread Verses 5-6
 - In these verses the description of God's function in our life changes. How is God being described here?
 - What does the imagery of the feast, the oil, and the cup mean to you?
 - What do we learn about God from these verses?
 - What do we learn about people from these verses?
 - What do we learn about our relationship with God from these verses?
